Documents Required in Addition to Registration Forms:

Copy of diploma/certificate from recognized school; OR detailed course list (including # of learning hours per course) & documentation of completed practicum hours with certificate/diploma from unrecognized school or program

Provide a Letter from your elder or teacher: or the teacher's contact Information, for written/verbal assurance of the applicant's qualifications to practice within the tradition of their culture.

- References, as listed above - Documentation of training and practicum hours - Proof of practice as a herbalist (ie. business license, letters from peers, etc.)
